TOURNAMENT RULES & CONDITIONS**

**1. MANAGEMENT**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> KGNS-MAZDA Ladies Amateur Open Golf Championship 2010 (hereinafter referred to as “The Championship”) shall be managed by an Organizing Committee (hereinafter referred to as “The Committee”) whose decision in all matters shall be final.

**2. VENUE & DATES**

The Tournament shall be played over 54 holes of **Kelab Golf Negara Subang Putra Course** or any other course deemed to be fit by the Committee from Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> June to 10<sup>th</sup> June 2010.

**3. SCHEDULE OF PLAY**

The schedule of play shall be as follows:

- a. Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June : Registration & Official Practice Round
- b. Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> June : First Round
- c. Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> June : Second Round – Cut-off to **60** leading players & ties (40 gross & 20 nett)
- d. Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> June : Final Round & Prize Presentation

**4. FORMAT OF PLAY**

**4.1** The KGNS LADIES AMATEUR OPEN GROSS & NETT Trophies shall be decided by stroke play over 3 rounds of 18 holes each day.

**There shall be a cut-off after 36 holes of play. The top 40 gross and ties & the top 20 nett and ties shall advance to the final round.**

**4.2** The KGNS LADIES AMATEUR OPEN TEAM GROSS & NETT Trophies shall be decided by stroke play over 2 rounds of 18 holes each day. Teams shall consist of two or three players from the same country and the best two scores for each day shall count.

**4.3** The Committee reserves the right, in the event of circumstances which make the playing of 54 holes impracticable, to cancel any round or rounds at its discretion.

**5. ELIGIBILITY**

**5.1** The tournament is open to lady golfers who are;

- a. amateur golfers in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status issued by the R&A Rules Ltd. Or
- b. have a maximum handicap of 24 (**USGA Handicap Index of 21.4**) which must be current on or before Friday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2010

**5.2** The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry without giving any reason. **Participants from non NHS Clubs may enter subject to the Committee’s sole discretion but would be eligible to win prizes in the Gross category only.**

**6. ENTRIES AND CLOSING DATE**

**6.1 Individual Event:**

The Entry Fee for each competitor is **RM350** for Malaysian players and **USD120** for foreign players and is inclusive of practice round, 3 days breakfast & lunch and caddie fees for the first two rounds. **Players for the final round will have to pay RM60 for caddie fee.** Caddie fees do not include tips.

#### **6.2 Team Event:**

The Entry Fee for each team is **RM120** for Malaysian teams and **USD40** for foreign teams.

All entries are to be made on the Official Entry Form and must reach the Tournament Secretariat Office by **12.00noon on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010.**

**6.3** Entries must be accompanied with the full Entry Fee payable by cash, cheque or money order made out to **“KELAB GOLF NEGARA SUBANG” or Bank Account No: 1141 6930 4499 / Swift Code: MBBEMYKL. (Fees are inclusive 5% Govt tax. Please attach the bank-in slip together with the entry form upon submission. Outstation cheques to add bank commission).** However, those unable to register within the stipulated times, may be accepted at the discretion of the Committee. Entry forms without payment may not be accepted.

**6.4** The field shall be limited to 120 competitors only. In the event that entries fall short or exceed the number, the Committee reserves the right to make amendments on the entry requirements without giving any reason whatsoever.

#### **7. WITHDRAWAL**

The Entry Fee will not be refunded if any competitor withdraws from the tournament and the withdrawal is made after 12.00noon on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010.

#### **8. REGISTRATION**

All competitors are required to register in person or by telephone by 12.00 noon on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2010. Failure to do so may result in the competitor being withdrawn from the Championship with no refund of any fees paid.

#### **9. RULES OF PLAY**

All play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A Rules Ltd. and the Local Rules of Kelab Golf Negara Subang as approved by the Committee.

#### **10. PRACTICE ROUND**

Practice round is on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2010 from 8.00am onwards. All competitors must leave the course by 4.00pm.

#### **11. DRAWS AND STARTING TIMES**

**11.1** Play shall be in groups of four (4) competitors at nine (9) minutes interval.

**11.2** The Tournament Committee will decide the draw and starting time for the first and second round. Draw for the final round will be arranged according to the scores; the lowest scores will tee off last from the first tee and the highest scores will tee off last from the tenth tee.

**11.3** The draws and starting times shall be posted at the Tournament Notice Board. Such posting shall be considered sufficient notice for information and distribution.

**11.4** The player shall start at the time laid down by the Tournament Committee. In the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at her starting point ready to play within five minutes after her starting time, the

penalty for failure to start on time shall be two strokes at the starting hole instead of disqualification. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is **DISQUALIFICATION**.

**11.5** The Committee reserves the right to change the draws and vary the starting times without giving any reason thereof.

## **12. PACE OF PLAY**

**12.1** The attention of all competitors is drawn to Rule 6-7 regarding undue delay. In the interest of fair play the Committee will not hesitate to impose the penalties provided by that Rule. Each hole has been given a maximum completion time based upon the length and difficulty of the hole. The maximum time allotted for the completion of 18 holes will be available prior to play. (Please refer to the Tournament Notice Board)

### **12.2 Definition of “Out of Position”**

The first group and any group after a starter’s gap will be considered to be “out of position” if at any time during the round, the group’s cumulative time exceeds the time allowed for the number of holes played. Any following group will be considered “out of position” if it is more than the starting time interval behind the group in front and has exceeded the time allowed for the number of holes played.

### **12.3 Procedure When Group is “Out of Position”**

**12.3.1** If the decision is taken to time the group, each player in the group will be subject to individual timing by a Rules Official. Each player in the group will be advised that they are “out of position” and are being timed.

**12.3.2** The maximum time allocated per shot is 40 seconds.

10 extra seconds are allowed for the first player to play:

- On the tee box;
- On the subsequent shots; and
- On the putting green.

The timing will start when a player has reached her ball, it is her turn to play and she is able to play without interference or distraction. On the putting green, timing will start when the player has had a reasonable amount of time to lift, clean and replace her ball, repair ball marks and move loose impediments on her line of putt. Time spent looking at the line from beyond the hole and/or behind the ball will count as time taken for the next stroke.

**12.3.3** Timing ceases when a group is either back in position in relation to the preceding group or within the allocated time for the holes played.

### **PENALTY OF BREACH OF CONDITION:**

1 bad time      Player will be warned by the Rules Official and told that if she has a further bad time she will be penalized.

	<u>Stroke Play</u>	<u>Match Play</u>
2 bad times	Penalty of one stroke	Loss of Hole
3 bad times	Further penalty of two strokes	Final Warning
4 bad times	Disqualification	Disqualification

### **12.4 Procedure When Again “Out of Position” During the Same Round**

If a group is “out of position” more than once during a round the above procedure will apply on each occasion. Bad times and the application of penalties in the same round will be carried forward until the round is completed. A player will not be penalized if she has a second bad time before being advised of her earlier bad time.

## **13. UNAUTHORIZED TRANSPORTATION**

Competitors shall walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permitted to ride by the Rules Officials. Use of any unauthorized transportation is prohibited.

**PENALTY:** Two strokes for each hole at which the breach occurred.

Maximum penalty per round – Four (4) strokes.

In the event of a breach between the play of two (2) holes, the penalty applies to the next hole.

**14. CADDIES**

A competitor shall not engage any person other than a KGNS registered caddie.

**PENALTY FOR BREACH OF CONDITION: DISQUALIFICATION.**

**15. APPROVED EQUIPMENTS**

**15.1 GOLF BALLS**

Only balls named on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by R & A Rules Ltd. may be used.

**15.2 CLUBHEADS**

**Appendix II, 5a of the Rules of Golf** states that, "The material and construction of, or any treatment to the face or the club-head, shall not have the effect at impact of a spring (test on file) or impart significantly more spin to the ball than a standard steel face, or have any other effect which would unduly influence the movement of the ball".

**PENALTY: DISQUALIFICATION**

**16. SCORECARDS**

**16.1** All competitors must submit their respective scorecard duly signed and counter signed by her marker as soon as possible after the completion of each round and in any event it shall not be later than 10 minutes after the completion of each round.

**16.2** A scorecard is deemed to be submitted the moment the competitor leaves the scoring area.

**17. PRIZES**

**17.1 The Champion**

The competitor who returns the lowest aggregate gross score over 54 holes shall be declared 'The Champion' and will be awarded the Championship Trophy.

**17.2 Nett Champion**

The competitor who returns the lowest aggregate nett score over 54 holes will be awarded the Nett Trophy.

**17.3 Prizes for other placings:**

**Team Event:**

Gross: Winner / Runner-up / Third

Nett: Winner / Runner-up / Third

**Daily medals (Day 1 & Day 2:**

A Division (0 -12) - 1 best gross and 1 best nett score

B Division (13 – 24) - 1 best gross and 1 best nett score

NOTE: A competitor shall be entitled to win only one gross or nett prize. In all cases gross score will take precedence over nett score with the exception of the overall nett winner. Number of prizes may be changed depending on the number of entries.

**18. COMPETITION CLOSED**

The Championship shall be deemed to have closed when the prizes have been awarded to the winners.

## **19. TIES**

**19.1** In the event of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place, the winner shall be decided by a sudden death play-off in the following order starting from the 18<sup>th</sup> hole and 9<sup>th</sup> hole. If the winner still cannot be decided, the sudden death will continue back to the 18<sup>th</sup> hole and 9<sup>th</sup> hole until the winner is decided by elimination. The purpose of the play-off is to decide the **WINNER** for the Championship only.

**19.2** In the event of a tie for any other place, the tie shall be decided by a count back on the card in the following order:-

Last 18 holes

Last 9 holes

Last 6 holes

Last 3 holes

And finally the last hole;

If the tie is still undecided, it shall be decided by lot.

## **20. AMATEUR STATUS**

**20.1** An amateur golfer must not accept a prize (other than a symbolic prize) or prize voucher of retail value in excess of £500 (RM3,500) or the equivalent. This limit applies to the total prizes or prize vouchers received by an amateur golfer in any one competition or series of competitions, excluding any hole-in-one prize (see Rule 3-2b).

**20.2** The limits prescribed in Rule 3-2a apply to a prize for a hole-in-one. However, such a prize may be accepted in addition to any other prize won in the same competition.

NOTE: The onus of receiving a prize or prizes that exceed the prescribed limits lies with the participant. The Committee and its sponsors shall not be liable for any action on players for any breach of Rules pertaining to Amateur Status.

## **21. DECISIONS**

**21.1** If a referee has been appointed by the Committee, his decision is final (Rule 34-2).

**21.2** In the absence of a referee, any dispute or doubtful point on the Rules must be put forward to the Committee whose decision shall be final (Rule 34-3).

## **22. DISPUTES & APPEAL**

**22.1** Any dispute that arises during the Tournament must be put forward to the Appeals Committee as soon as practicable upon completion of a round and in any event it shall not be later than 15 minutes after completion of the said round.

**22.2** A penalty of disqualification may in exceptional cases be waived, modified or imposed by the Appeals Committee.

## **23. ETIQUETTE**

All players should practise good etiquette as detailed out in Section 1 of the Rules of Golf. The overriding principle is that consideration should be shown to others on the course at all times.

### Serious Breach of Etiquette

The following may be considered “serious breaches of etiquette” for this competition:-

- i. Usage of hand phone during a round to the annoyance and distractions of other players.
- ii. Verbal abuse of fellow competitor / official / staff.
- iii. Intentionally distracting or offending fellow competitor.

Note: Any other ‘breaches of etiquette’ not listed above will be dealt with by the Committee on individual basis. Penalty: Disqualification

## **24. DRUGS**

Players must not make use of any drug to enhance performance. Should a player show evidence of use of a drug for non-therapeutic purposes, the Committee may require the player to undergo a drug test. Any player infringing this Condition may be disqualified. Players who are on medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from the R&A via the Tournament Office.

## **25. INCLEMENT WEATHER AND SUSPENSION OF PLAY**

The Tournament Committee will make every effort to complete an event in its entirety. However, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to suspend or abandon play as necessary if weather-related circumstances require such action. In the unlikely event the course is unplayable and abandons play or other conditions warranting such action, the Committee then will decide the tournament and all competitors will be informed accordingly.

## **26. INDEMNITY / LIABILITIES**

Malaysian Golf Association, the sponsors, the Committee, Kelab Golf Negara Subang and their staffs will not be responsible for any loss, damage or harm, or any form of injuries that the participants of the tournament may suffer as a result of their participation in this tournament.

## **27. DRESS CODE**

KGNS observes the following rule of 'Attire for Lady Golfers' and participants are required to comply:

- a) Headgear (optional) – Cap / Hat / Visor
- b) Dress – Sports shirts with collar and sleeves and mock turtleneck.  
Trousers/pants, skirts or shorts (not more than 4 inches above the knees).  
Jogging Shorts and Pants/Shorts with Denim/Jeans material are not allowed.  
Ladies' tops that are designed to be worn out for golf, must not be more than 4 inches and not less than 2 inches below the belt line, and these should have collars and sleeves.
- c) Footwear – Proper golf shoes with soft spikes.
